To apply to sell in the Chico Certified Farmers' Markets:

1. Completely fill out the application to sell form.
2. Return the completed form along with initialed copy of Rules for Sellers, signed document receipt, initialed parking map, and copies of required permits, licenses, and agreements (see below) by mail to (DO NOT EMAIL APPLICATIONS):

When received, your completed application will be submitted to the Chico Certified Farmers' Market Board of Directors for approval (Board of Director meetings occur on the third Wednesday of the month). The decision will be based upon the current market commodity mix. If there is a space available for YOUR PRODUCT(S) in our markets:

4. Once your application is approved, you should contact (phone/email) the Market Manager to arrange to sell in the markets that you have been approved for.

FEE STRUCTURE:

The Chico Certified Farmers' Markets charge a flat fee for daily stall space rental. A seller can only become a member of the Chico Certified Farmers' Market by applying and then being approved by the board of directors. The yearly membership fee is \$50.

The following are the daily stall space rental (flat) fees that you will be charged for selling in the following markets:

Downtown Chico, Saturdays, Year Round

Year round \$30 members, \$60 non-members

North Valley Plaza, Wednesdays

June-November \$25 members, \$50 non-members

Oroville, Saturdays

May-October \$20 members, \$40 non-members

Paradise, Tuesdays

June-October \$20 members, \$40 non-members

Paradise, Thursdays

June-August \$20 members, \$40 non-members

*Fee structure subject to change by
decision of the Board of Directors.

Reservation and Cancellation Policy: Advance stall space reservations are required for all Markets. If a seller reserves a space and fails to either cancel 48 hours prior to a market or does not appear to do business on a Market Day, a \$25.00 penalty fee will be levied that will have to be paid before attending your next market.
